



## VISITING THE PHYSIO AT THE HOSPITAL

We call her "the physio" for short.




First, we will find the right desk and check in to tell the physio that we have arrived.

We'll bring something to play with while we wait.




The physio will come out to collect us.

She may use a little ruler to measure how far our arms and legs can move.

This is called a goniometer.





The physio will also ask us to do some activities.

This helps her to understand how our body moves.







Some activities will be on the floor



Some may be sitting activities











Some may be standing activities, like climbing a step or a little run




## Some activities will be easy and fun




Others will be a bit harder.
